 - Students will write 1-2 sentences explaining how the object relates to the main character of the book. Please use the Paper Bag Book Report Form attached. Try to use objects that will also give details about the setting, problem, and solution within the story.
 - Students will share their Paper Bag Book Reports with their peers upon returning to school.
- Complete and return the attached signed report form and Paper Bag Book Report to your student's homeroom teacher on the first day of school August 26, 2024.
