Applicants should be prepared to articulate an active faith in Jesus Christ and demonstrate the ability to appropriately engage students of various age-levels.

Responsibilities:

- Teach science courses to upper school students in grades 6-11, including Biology, Chemistry, and Physical Science
- Develop lesson plans and instructional materials that align with our Christian values and principles
- Create a positive and engaging classroom environment that fosters student learning and growth
- Assess and evaluate student progress and provide feedback on academic performance
- Communicate effectively with students, parents, and colleagues
- Participate in school events, meetings, and professional development opportunities
- Model effective teacher/parental partnering through timely and proactive communication with parents in support of student behavioral and academic success (posting of assignments, grades, conferencing, etc.); Assist with enlarging the vision and mission of Chestertown Christian

- Bachelor's degree in Science or a related field
- Teaching experience, preferably in a Christian school environment
- Strong commitment to integrating Christian principles into the classroom
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to develop and implement engaging and effective lesson plans
- Positive and collaborative attitude
- Holds to a personal commitment to Jesus Christ and is active in a local evangelical church
- Is in complete agreement with and committed to the CCA's Statement of Faith
- Able to articulate a Biblical worldview as the foundation of strong Christian
